

Driving Range Safety Guidelines

- We are unable to offer hire clubs at the moment so please ensure ALL players have their own personal golf clubs to use, you will not be permitted to share.
- There will be a separate queueing system for the range so please see signs for details and remember to stay 2 meters apart whilst waiting.
- The range will operate with 18 bays and once full it will be a one in one out policy. The queue for the range will be outside so please plan for all weather.
- Once at the front of the queue please wait to be called forward to the range doorway to be served, the building will remain closed.
- Range balls will be paid for and issued at the doorway desk. We are only accepting contactless card payments at this time. NO CASH.
- Range balls will be sanitised during cleaning and baskets will be sanitised before being handed over.
- Next you will be instructed to follow the arrows through the external gate and into the range via the top bay.
- Once inside the range the walk way behind the bays will be a one-way system so please find the first available bay to play in.
- You must stay in the bay and on the range mat at ALL times. Our bays are 3 meters wide so whilst on the mat you will comply with social distancing rules. You must not touch, lean or sit on the wooden range dividers. Stay on the green mat at ALL times.
- Each mat will have a small and high tee, these should not be removed.
- The range will be an individual sports activity and is not suited to groups wishing to socialise. You will not be permitted to stand in the walk way, share bays, spectate or use range seating. If you come in a group of 2 or more you may not get bays next to each other and even if you are from the same household you will not be permitted to share.
- Spectators will not be permitted anywhere on the range.
- Once you have hit all the range balls please take your basket and leave the range via the one-way system following signs for the exit. Do not leave the way you came in or through the pro shop.
- Place your empty basket in the designated area and exit via the bottom bay.
- These restrictions are in place for your safety and the safety of others. They are policies set out by England Golf and the Government so must be followed with no exceptions. We will operate a zero-tolerance approach for anyone not following them and you will be asked to leave immediately.
